



Onside & Location Services

“Am I being tracked?”

Onside captures your location only when you check-in, check-out, auto-arrive, and auto-exit a property.

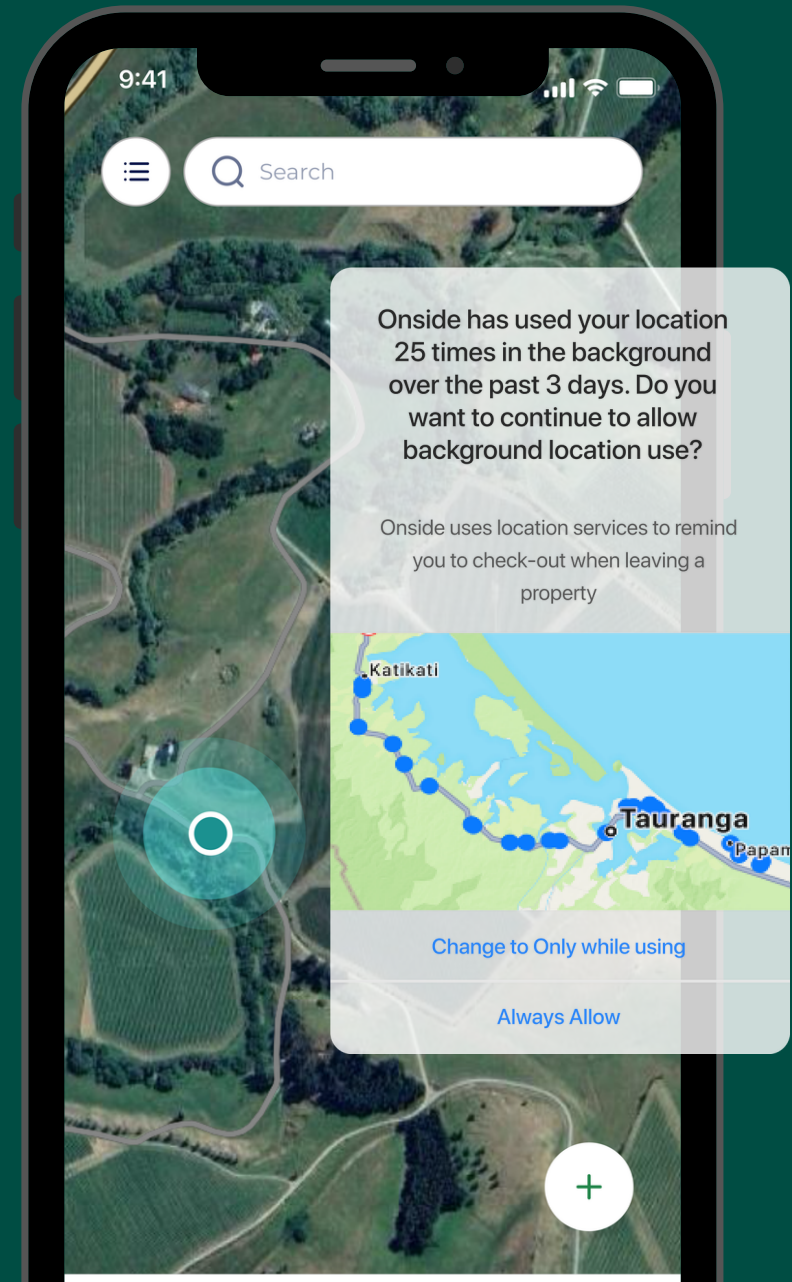
- If you do use Auto-arrival and you arrive near a geofenced property, your location is briefly used to detect when you enter a property boundary.
- If you do not use Auto-arrival, but have enabled location services for Onside, your location will be stored when you check-in or check-out.

Outside of this, Onside does not track your location. Your location data is **never shared** with other users, your company, or any third parties.

You can also see your own position on the digital property map as a blue dot (like Google Maps) - visible only to you.



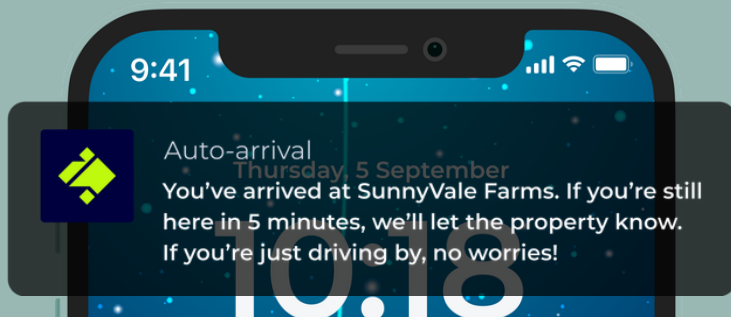
Auto-arrival is an optional feature. Onside can still be used without enabling location services





If I auto-arrive at a property I'm just driving past, does the property get notified?

No, there is a 5 minute window from when you get an auto-arrival notification. If you are not on that property after 5 minutes, the property admin is not notified.



Does auto-arrival drain my phone battery?

For the average Onside user, it may use around 5% of your battery. You can check how much battery Onside uses in your phone's settings.

If you use the Auto-arrival **high accuracy mode**, it will increase your battery usage. We recommend this setting if you can charge your phone during the day.
