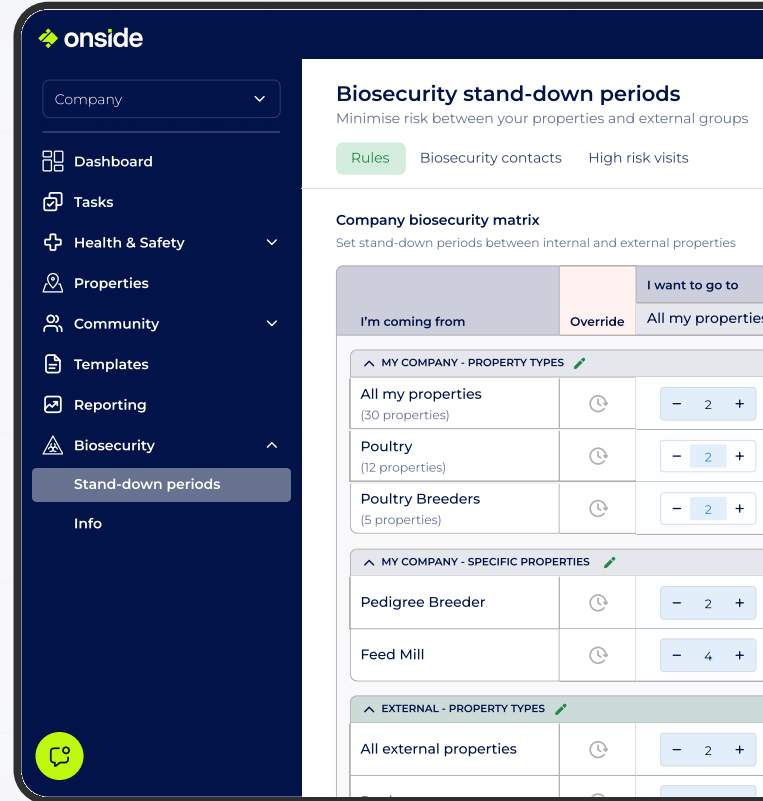

Biosecurity stand-down periods

Automatically restrict people movements between your company's properties, and external properties based on their recent check-ins

What are stand-down periods?

People moving between properties are one of the most common vectors for disease transmission.

A stand-down period is a set amount of time that must pass before a person can enter another property after visiting a site. It's a practical way to reduce the risk of spreading pests or diseases between properties.

Observing the required stand-down period gives time for contaminants to be cleared from clothing, vehicles, and equipment - reducing the chance of cross-contamination.

SETTING UP INTERNAL RULES

How it works

In the web portal, your biosecurity matrix automatically includes all of your company's properties.

You can customise the matrix to set up your normal 'peace time' biosecurity stand-down rules. You have the ability to set no stand-down if it's applicable.

You can create specific rules between individual properties or groups of properties.

Some properties will automatically inherit values set in other rows, and will appear in the matrix like this. This helps you visualise how your rules affect other rows and properties.

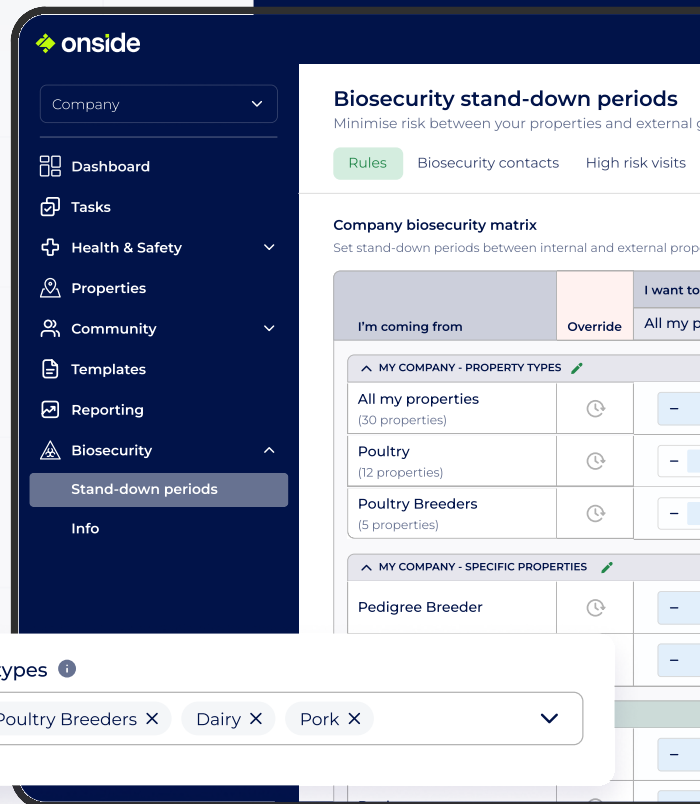
SETTING UP EXTERNAL RULES

How it works

You can define stand-down rules for properties outside of your company.

Industry-based rules: apply blanket rules based on property types - for example, you might want to define a stand-down period into your properties from external poultry and pork properties.

Company-specific rules: apply specific rules for individual companies, like for trusted companies you work with regularly. This lets you tailor stand-down periods to reflect established working relationships.

Add biosecurity contacts

You can set up biosecurity contacts to receive notifications when someone has breached a stand-down period, and they can manage the person's arrival. This includes accepting or declining a person's visit and noting why the person was or wasn't allowed on site after they have had a discussion.

You can assign primary and secondary contacts to your properties.

What happens when someone breaches a stand-down period?



Often a person arriving may not even be aware that they should be stood down. Onside will automatically let them know that they are breaching a stand-down, and when they can return.



The person arriving receives a mobile notification when their Auto-arrival detects they have arrived at the property



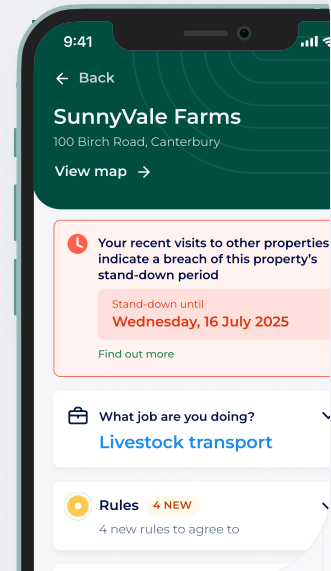

!! You may be breaching a stand-down period

If you're on SunnyVale Farms, please check-in and contact the biosecurity manager. Just passing by? We'll only notify the property if you're still here in 5 minutes.



In the app, they'll see this notice when they check-in, with details about their stand-down, and who on the property to contact



What should the biosecurity contact person do?



Onside will automatically let a property's biosecurity contact know when a stand-down has been breached so that they can respond to the visit quickly.



The nominated biosecurity contact person will get notified if someone arrives and they are breaching a stand-down period



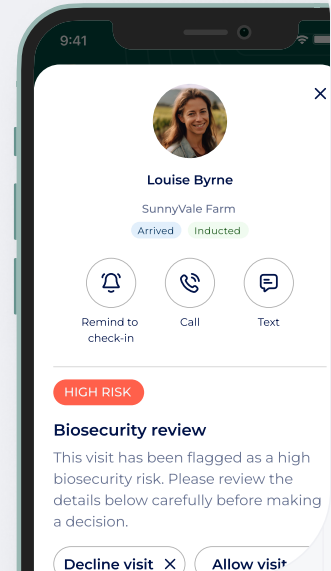

!! Potential stand-down period breach

Posetone Mauga has arrived at SunnyVale Farms but hasn't checked-in yet. Their recent visits to other properties indicate that visiting would breach this property's stand-down period



The biosecurity contact person can then follow up with the visitor to discuss their visit, and allow or decline their entry



Overrides

What to do in the event of a biosecurity incursion?

If you detect a disease on any property, it's important to act fast to protect your wider operation and community.

You can apply temporary stand-down overrides to affected properties. Instead of a 1-night stand-down, you could instantly enforce a - say, 4-nights stand-down - to swiftly contain a biosecurity threat.

This allows you to communicate urgent biosecurity changes to everyone arriving, reducing the risk of disease spread between properties.

Once the biosecurity event is resolved, simply remove the override.

REPORTING

High risk visits

Any visit that triggers a biosecurity stand-down alert - whether allowed or declined - is stored in your high-risk visit history in the web portal.

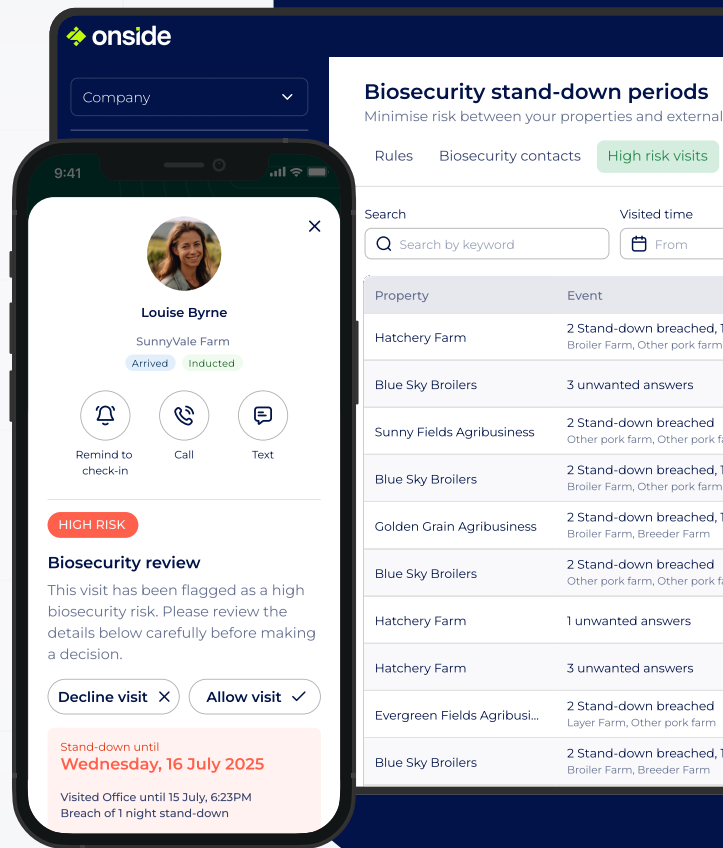
This record is important to keep, particularly during a tracing event - when you may need to provide evidence of who accessed your properties and why.

There are valid reasons for allowing a visit, but it's essential to document them.

Biosecurity check-in questions

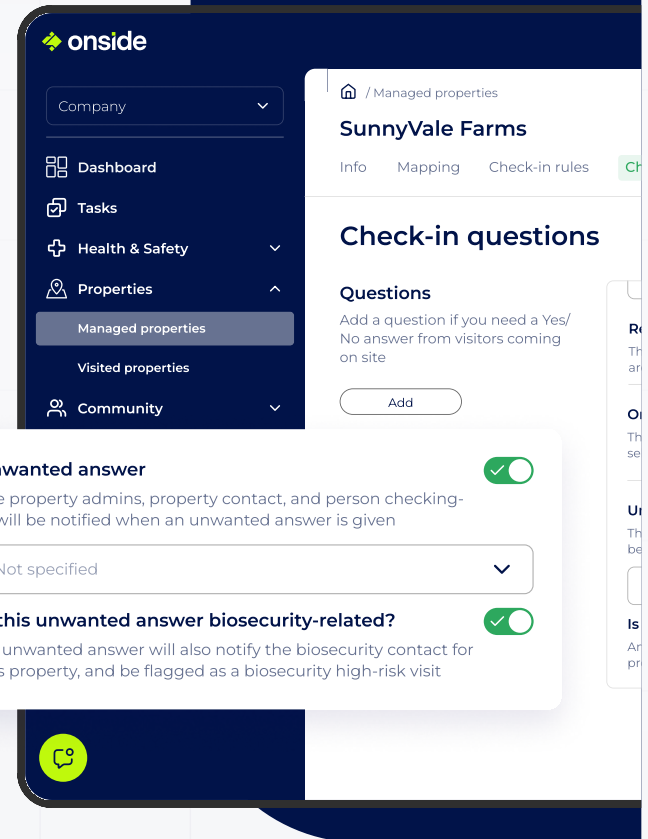
To add a further layer of protection - even when other companies are not part of the Onside network - make sure you have set up your check-in questions.

You can add in questions like:

Have you been on another pork or poultry farm in the last 14 days?

Did you observe a 48hr stand-down before coming to this property?

Add these questions as 'biosecurity-related', so that the biosecurity contact for the property will get notified about unwanted check-in answers.

Digital check-in footprint

Onside uses check-in history to identify where people have been, and if they should be observing a stand-down period before coming to your property - based on your preset biosecurity matrix.



Auto-arrival

Leverage Auto-arrival to get notified immediately if a visitor arrives and should be stood-down, even if they haven't check-in.

With 3.5M check-ins and 22K mapped properties, Onside is a large agri-network. You're part of the network too, so you can set rules for stand-downs across industries and companies in Onside.
